Ask your child to make different sized flat circles. Now lay them on top of each other, like the picture on the other side.

A famous artist called Kandinsky used shapes like these in his paintings.

Your child can change around the circles to keep changing their Play-Doh picture.

They could make flat squares instead of circles or any other flat shapes that they enjoy.
