Cut out 4 coloured squares, about the size of your hand. (You can cut out more if you like)

2

Rip and tear lots of coloured paper circles and put them on top of each other like on the front of this card.

(You can cut the circles with scissors if you like.)

A famous artist called Kandinsky used shapes just like these in his paintings.

Try this:

Swap the coloured circles around or cut new ones.

Start a new picture using only squares, stars or other shapes

When you like the look of your picture you can glue it down.
