USE YOUR WATERCOLOURS

Grab your box of watercolour paints, paintbrush and paper

Also:

- some toilet roll (to clean your brush on)
- a cup of water (to wash your brush)

1. Dip your brush into the water
2. Now make a watery circle or any shape you like on your paper
3. Now dip your wet brush onto one of your watercolour blocks
4. Cover just one part of your wet circle with the paint
5. Twizzle your brush in the cup of water to wash it
6. Now dip your wet brush onto a different watercolour block
7. Add this colour to your wet circle on the paper

See how the colours blend together?

TRY THIS:

Use different colours to get different effects

Try different shapes – splodges, squares, stars – anything!

NOW TRY:

Use the watercolours on dry paper and see how that works?
